



CAR SHOW FAQs

1. I have a vintage vehicle to display but I'm concerned about damage:

We have never had a problem. The car show display area, depending on which site, is compact dirt, black top, or small gravel. We place vehicles in the same location which allows owners to keep an eye out for each other.

2. Can I choose my own spot?

In limited cases. Usually the first car in takes the first spot and so on. If there is a specific need it can be addressed.

3. Is there room for erecting a canopy?

In our primary display location there is a limited number of spots large enough for a vehicle and canopy. It will be assigned on a first come first serve basis. Pre-registered vehicles have the advantage.

4. What time is check-in?

Check-in for both Saturday and Sunday is 8AM and no earlier. Those arriving earlier than this time will have to wait outside the fence area. People inside before 8 AM are Fair Committee personnel setting up.

5. Can I leave my vehicle in its space overnight?

We have security personnel patrol the grounds all night but we cannot assume liability or responsibility for vehicles left overnight. You may leave your vehicle at your risk.

6. What is the latest date that I can pre-register?

You should have your pre-registration mailed by NLT July 6th. Make sure your check is made out to Celebrate!Spanaway Committee, Inc. Pre-registration forms and checks must be in our hands by July 16 to qualify for the \$10 entry. Please print your email legibly and you will receive a confirmation of receipt.

7. Can I get an application for a friend?

At website www.celebratespanaway.org click on "Fair Applications Forms" then "Application Forms" then "Auto Display Application". You can download the application. If you don't have an internet connection call 253-537-7363 and ask for Roger. You will be mailed an application(s). Leave a message if phone is not answered.

8. What type of food vendors are on location?

Food vendors can change from year to year. The school grounds are located fairly close to a couple of restaurants and there are several fast foods places within 3 miles. While we probably will have food vendors at the fair we cannot say what their menus will be.

9. Is smoking allowed?

There is no smoking on school grounds. We will have a designated smoking area outside the fence.

10. I can only come for one day is there a discount?

The price for admission covers two days and we do not discount for a one- day entry. Most car shows charge this much or more for one day. Keep in mind that we give awards out on both days. Persons attending both days have twice the chance of getting an award. The People's Choice and Fair's Choice Awards are given on Sunday only.

11. Will the car show be cancelled if it rains and the application fee returned?

It seldom rains in July and we have only incurred it twice in ten years. We will be running the fair and car show rain or shine so there will not be any application fees returned.

12. Will you have dash plaques and what type of awards do you give out?

This year we will give out dash plaques to the first 75 entries. Awards can vary and may include the following:

13. We're coming from a distance; what hotel(s) can you recommend?

There are eleven mid-priced, national chain hotels within six miles of the fairgrounds. From I-5 north take exit 129 East (74th St); turn south onto Hosmer. The motels line Hosmer between 74th and 90th streets. To continue on to the fairgrounds, stay on Hosmer going south until it becomes Steel St then Spanaway Loop Road. From Spanaway Loop turn east onto 152nd St (Old Military Road) to Pacific Avenue (SR-7). Turn right (south) onto Pacific Avenue to 166th street, then west on 166th to the fairground entrance.
